



# SURREY LADIES SUPER LEAGUE PLAYING RULES 2022 - 2023

# (1) <u>REGISTRATION</u>

- A. A Team must register a minimum of 5 Players to a maximum of 10 Players per season, with a proviso that the team has enough players should they be eligible to enter the Champions Cup. (Should we have between 41 45 players register then then the maximum number of players will increase to 11 etc.
- B. A Team may register new players up to and including 30<sup>th</sup> September in any year, as long as they do not exceed the maximum players for their team.
- C. All players must be registered to the Surrey Super League and the registration fees paid before they play.
- D. There will be no limit to the number of outside county players registered to your Team.

#### E. FORMAT

- A. Order of play decided by nearest the Bull
- B. All scores to be recorded for Averages.

2 SINGLES GAMES PER NGHT – 501 BEST OF 5 LEGS 1 Point for each leg won and Bonus point given for 3-0 win

- C. All matches to commence no later than 8.30pm PROMPT, with practice boards available before start of play.
- D. Any player unable to attend any of the Match Nights must inform the League Secretary by text on 07860 827 161 by 2pm latest on the day of the match, Failure to do so will result in a 2-point penalty to their singles score. (Exceptional circumstances will be considered at a player's request, and a decision made by the League Secretary and Team Captains- their decision will be FINAL)
- E. All legs with be straight start Double finish.
- F. When both players are at the Board no more than six practice darts will be thrown.
- G. When you have played your game, you will need to stay on the board to check or score the next game on.
- H. At the end of the Playing season the top five players' singles scores from each Team will be totalled to decide the Super League winning Team this team will represent Surrey at the Champions Cup.]

# F. <u>GENERAL</u>

- A. All matches to be played on Friday evenings, every two weeks wherever possible, at the Central Ward Club.
- B. All matches to be played on a Mission Samurai Dartboard of 1-20 clock pattern which confirms to the UKDA approved standard.
- C. No player will remove her darts from the board until the score has been called by the Chalker. This includes game shot.

Once the darts are retrieved from the board the player cannot object to the score called. Darts falling from the board before a player has retrieved them from the board does not count in the score.

- D. Any dart thrown mistakenly after the game shot has been achieved shall not count.
- E. The Chalker alone will be responsible for telling a player what she has score, or what is left. And then only when asked to do so by the player on the oche. If a supporter or team member of the thrower is heard to call the score finish or what is left, then the throw will become void. A game is not finished until 501 has been achieved.

# G. <u>RESULT SHEETS</u>

A. All players are responsible for checking that the correct score results have been recorded from their matches before they are handed to the League Secretary.

# H. FINANCIAL MATTERS

- A. Each player shall pay £25.00 to join the Ladies Super League The £25.00 covers £10.00 for UKDA membership - £10.00 to Surrey County to run the County and £5.00 to the Ladies Super League. You will then be required to pay Match Fees of £3.00 per week – missed weeks will also be charged.
- B. All monies taken as match fees during the season will be returned as points money (i.e., so much per point won). This amount will be worked out by the League Secretary.
- C. Anyone failing to play 100% of their games at the end of the playing season, will be withdrawn from the League and all monies paid to the Super League will be forfeit.

#### I. <u>COMPETITIONS</u>

- A. Competitions will be held on a Friday played down to a Final which will then be played on Finals Night.
- B. Entry to all competitions is £5.00 per player per competition.
- C. You can play with any player in the pairs and triples as long as they have paid their Super league Registration Fee.
- D. The Competition draw will be made on the night once all confirmed entries have been registered.
- E. A Ladies Pentathlon will be organised in the playing season It will be open to 20 Players who have paid their Super League Registration Fees. Notification of date and cost will be advertised. As places are limited you will need to register your interest and pay a deposit of £10.00 to secure your place.

#### J. <u>FINALLY</u>

- A. UKDA Rules and the Surrey Darts Organisation Constitution apply.
- B. Any matters arising which are not covered by the following rules shall be decided by the Super League Secretary, Chairman and General Secretary, whose decision will be FINAL. The committee cannot change the rules that have been discussed as above and passed by the floor.

#### C. A note to anyone who wishes to be considered for selection to the Ladies County Side

If you miss 3 Super League match nights consecutively, you will no longer be eligible for selection, until you have played 66% of games, and can then be reconsidered.
